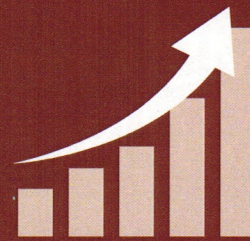


ENDOWMENT

An **endowment** is a lasting gift to your community. When you create a charitable fund with the Adams County Community Foundation (ACCF), your gift is invested to grow over time. The earnings are used to support the causes you care about – not just today, but forever. It's truly a gift that keeps on giving.

HOW IT WORKS

- Dollars are pooled and invested
- Annual earnings are distributed

WAYS TO GIVE

- Bequests from a will or estate

- Stocks, bonds, or mutual funds
- Real estate or life insurance
- Retirement plan assets or IRA distributions

WHY GIVE THROUGH ACCF?

ACCF is a 501(c)(3) public nonprofit led by local volunteers. Donations are pooled and invested to build a permanent fund supporting community projects and programs. As assets grow, so does our ability to improve community life.

A GIFT OF A LIFETIME

Generous donors have established many endowment funds – lasting gifts that will continue supporting our community for generations to come. You can contribute to an existing fund or establish one of your own.

TYPES OF ENDOWMENT FUNDS

- Unrestricted Fund – Allows the foundation to address the community's greatest needs.
- Field of Interest Fund – Supports a cause or issue you care about (e.g., animal welfare, arts, health).
- Designated Fund – Supports a specific nonprofit organization you choose.
- Scholarship Fund – Helps students with education costs, based on criteria you help define.
- Organizational Fund – Created by a nonprofit to provide long-term financial support for its mission.
